

## List of documents and information required for divorce proceedings (for each spouse)

This list is for guidance only

- Full address, telephone numbers, including cell phone numbers;
- Date on which each spouse resides at his or her last known address;
- Social Insurance Number (S.I.N) of both spouses;
- Name, address and telephone number of your current employers;
- Your position (as an employee) in your employer's organization and your annual salary;
- Mother's maiden name and father's full name;
- Your date and place of birth;
- Date and place of your wedding;
- Copies of your birth certificates (originals may be required at a later date);
- Copies of your marriage certificate (a certified copy or original will be required at a later date) and marriage contract (prenuptial), if applicable;
- Your marital status before the wedding (divorced, single, widowed) and documents to prove it;
- Name, age, sex and date of birth of all children born of this marriage;
- Copies of birth certificates for all children (originals may be required at a later date);
- Date of separation;
- Are you going to ask for the QPP amounts paid for each of you to be shared?
- List of your possessions and their market value;
- A copy of your most recent provincial tax return and notice of assessment;

- Your last three pay slips;
- If income is low: monthly budget for each spouse since separation (sources of income, amounts and expenses: rent, electricity, water, heating, internet, telephone, cable TV, groceries, transportation, clothing, entertainment. Expenses related to children must be indicated separately);
- Your intentions regarding childcare (i.e. how do you plan to share parenting responsibilities and child-related expenses?)
- How do you plan to divide the family estate?
- What are your respective expectations regarding child support?
